REMINDER

Any employer that incurred a claim during the GREEN year and is currently participating in a WORKERS' COMPENSATION GROUP RATING PROGRAM,

must complete 2 hours of safety training to be compliant with Ohio BWC guidelines.

Private Employer green year:

July 1, 2015- September 30, 2016

Public Employer green year:

January 1, 2015 - March 31, 2016

There are a number of options available for completing this requirement, employers can:

- Complete 2 hours of online training @ www.bwclearningcenter.com
- Attend a training session provided by the BWC's Division of Safety & Hygiene
- Dates, times, and locations

- Complete the BWC's online Accident Analysis course and the corresponding report.
