Be on the **LOOKOUT**

There will be a few changes to some of the workers' compensation rules you've grown accustomed to. A few changes to note are:

- **Statue of Limitations for filing an injury or death claim will change from two years to one**
- **The time to file an appeal to court may be extended allowing either party sixty days to file**

Drug testing changes include all controlled substances and the threshold limits are being changed to comply with the code of Federal regulations

REMINDER

Any employer that incurred a claim during the **GREEN year** and is currently participating in a WORKERS' COMPENSATION GROUP RATING PROGRAM,

must complete 2 hours of safety training to be compliant with Ohio BWC guidelines.

**Private Employer green year:
July 1, 2014- September 30, 2015**

**Public Employer green year:
January 1, 2015 - March 31, 2016**

There are a number of options available for completing this requirement, employers can:

- Complete 2 hours of online training @ www.bwclearningcenter.com
- Attend a training session provided by the BWC's **Division of Safety & Hygiene**
