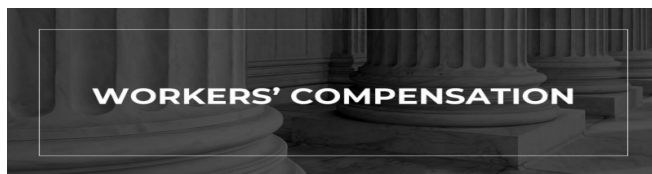

BWC Proposes Reducing Premium Rates for Private Employers by 12%



The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation announced it's calling for a 12% reduction in premium rates for private employers beginning July 1 from its board of directors.

Should the 12% reduction be approved, private employers would see significant savings totaling \$163.5 million over this year's premiums, which by the way, according to a BWC press release, "are already at their lowest rates in at least 40 years."

The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) credits Ohio employers for their continued commitment to reducing

workplace injuries as one of the reasons such a reduction can take place. Bureau administrator and CEO, Sarah Morrison said in a press release, "we know the less employers spend on premiums, the more they can invest in their communities and in safer work environments for their employees. And when that happens, we all benefit."

The board is scheduled to vote on the request February 23rd
