Blood Pressure

High blood pressure, also called hypertension, can be caused by lifestyle factors or by genetics, or usually a combination of both. It can be dangerous if left untreated, raising your risk for heart attack and stroke.

Things you can do to help control high blood pressure:

1. Maintain a healthy weight
2. Exercise—get at least 150 minutes of moderate intensity exercise a week.
3. Cut back on salt
4. Follow the DASH Diet—Dietary Approaches to Stopping Hypertension
5. Power up probiotics
6. Eat out less often
7. Monitor your numbers at home
8. Stop smoking
9. Cut your caloric intake
10. Find a way to relax

EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE OSHA ACT

OSHA has developed very specific responsibilities for employers covered by the Act. OSHA doesn't have to explain these responsibilities to you when they visit until the Closing Conference. It is the employer's responsibility to know what OSHA requires. These responsibilities are important and failure to know them can add thousands of dollars in fines.

Responsibilities - The Employer Must:

- Meet general duty responsibilities to provide a workplace free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to employees, and comply with standards, rules and regulations issued under the Act.
- Be familiar with mandatory OSHA standards and make copies available to employees upon request.
- Inform all employees about OSHA
