New Area Code on Way:

What do you need to know about new area code? Current phone numbers will not change. Important information about the new area code.

- Calls currently considered local will remain local calls. Calls between 937 and the new 326 are local calls.
- Long distance calling will not change
- 911 and other three-digit numbers (222, 311, 411, 811, etc) if available in the local community, not change.
- Customers should begin or continue to identify their phone number with the area code.

The new area code will be rolled out in about two months. For information call PUCO at 1.800.686.7626.



Never shorten 2020 to 20 on legal documents. The date could be changed to something in the past or even the future. Consumer advocates urge people to use the extra two numbers to date documents with 2020 simply to protect yourself. **"Protect yourself, do not abbreviate 2020."**



Be Counted! Census 2020

The United States Census is a head-count of every person living in the United States and takes place every 10-years. Households participate to be sure the government represents all people.

Your responses to the Census are safe and protected by Federal Law. All answers are used to create data to review and persons names are removed once the answers are received-the information is confidential! By law, your answers cannot be used against you.

For the first time, this year people can choose how they want to respond to the Census; by online, by mail or by phone. The U.S. Census Bureau has taken strong precautions to keep online responses secure.

WHO PARTICIPATES IN US CENSUS BUREAU SURVEYS?

Everyone who has established a residence in the US is counted, including individuals with work visas, international students, and unauthorized immigrants, but excluding temporary visitors such as tourists.

WHEN SHOULD I BE EXPECTING TO RECEIVE MY SURVEY NOTIFICATION?

You don't need to sign-up; the Census Bureau is hard at work making sure they get to you. You will receive a letter in the [mail](#) between March 12th - 20th.

Those who do not respond online or by mail to the initial requests are visited in person by a team of Census surveyors.
