**CONTACT:** Quincy E. Pope Sr. - City Manager (Trotwood, Ohio) – Pursuant to Governor Mike DeWine’s removal of COVID-19 pandemic health orders on June 2, 2021, the City of Trotwood has reopened its parks, rental facilities, and government facilities for public business. Furthermore, Governor DeWine’s order removed facial covering protocols, social distancing guidelines, and capacity restrictions for indoor and outdoor events. Therefore, the July 6, 2021, Trotwood City Council meeting and future meetings will be open to the public.

While these requirements have been lifted, we are still at-risk for COVID-19 illness. Therefore, the City of Trotwood urges everyone to continue to follow safe protocols to protect themselves and others, especially those individual who are not fully vaccinated.

### Protecting Workers from Heat Stress By Gary Hanson

Each year hundreds of employees who are required to work in hot environments or outside in direct sun light suffer heat related illnesses. These may range from heat cramps to heat stroke. In serious cases exposure to hot temperature or heat can cause death. There are precautions that should be taken anytime temperatures rise into the middle 80s and where physical labor is also required:

Know what to do if an employee suffers a Heat Related Illness

1. Call 911 immediately .
2. Move employee, if possible to a cool/shaded area.
3. Fan and mist employee with cool water and/or apply ice.
4. Provide the employee with cool water if able to drink.
5. Have someone stay with the employee until help arrives.
6. Where possible modify work schedules and provide more frequent work breaks.
7. Have employees get a good night's rest. Summertime can pose serious risk to employees who work in hot environments.
