What you can do to avoid a scam

1. Block unwanted calls and text messages.
2. Don't give your personal or financial information in response to a request that you didn't expect.
3. If you get an email or text message from a company you do business with and you think it's real, it's still best not to click on any links. Instead, contact them using a website you know is trustworthy or look up their phone number.
4. Resist the pressure to act immediately. Legitimate businesses will give you time to make a decision.
5. Know how scammers tell you to pay. NEVER pay someone who insists you pay with a gift card or by using a money transfer service.
6. Stop and talk to someone you trust before you do anything else.
