TROTWOOD FIRE & RESCUE TO CONDUCT HYDRANT TESTING— APRIL 6, 2021 COMMUNITY NEWS

In an effort to assure an adequate water supply for fighting fires and to help maintain the lowest Insurance Ratings possible, Trotwood Fire and Rescue personnel will be checking all fire hydrants for operation and flow. Trotwood Fire & Rescue will conduct fire hydrant checks between the dates of May 1, 2021 through May 31, 2021. We recommend that you check your tap water for clarity before doing any laundry during these dates.

Trotwood Fire & Rescue personnel makes every attempt not to disturb the rust in the water lines. Trotwood Fire & Rescue and the Montgomery County Water Dept. no longer offer rust re-

moving detergents. Should you get rust in your clothing, please follow these steps:

- Do not permit the clothing to dry.
- Purchase a detergent with rust removing agents and follow the cleaning instructions.
