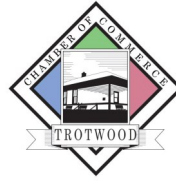

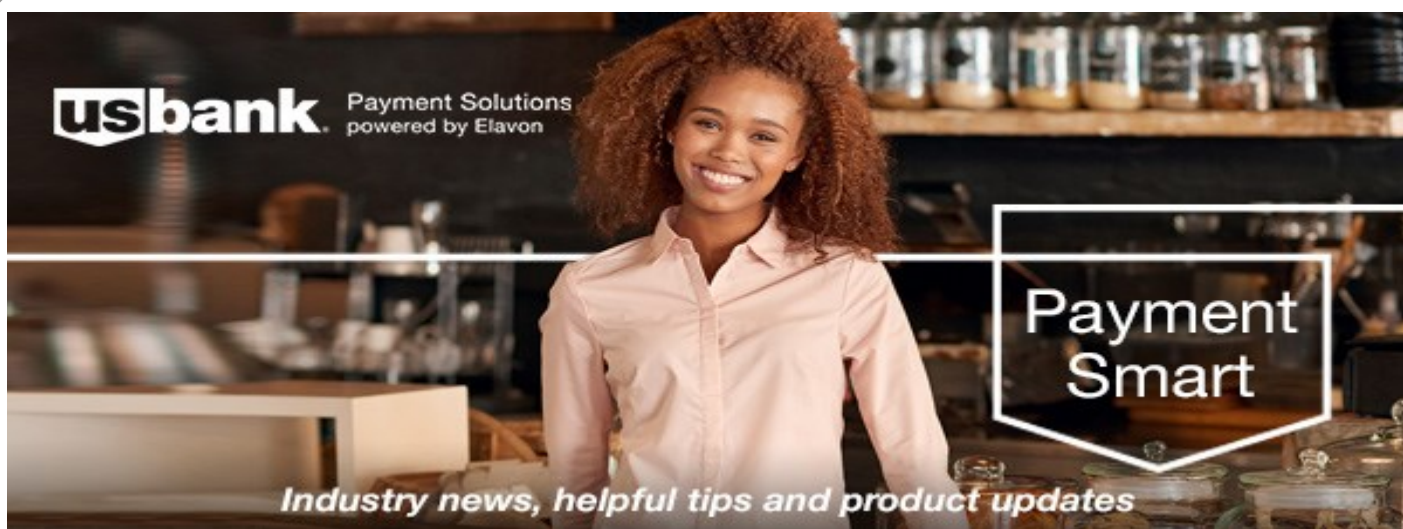

Fraud prevention: Don't skip the zip

How to avoid card brand AVS noncompliance fees. Do you accept card-not-present (CNP) payments by eCommerce, mail order/telephone order and manual key entry? Then to help mitigate fraud and avoid paying additional acceptance costs, you'll want to be sure you and your employees aren't bypassing address verification as part of your payment acceptance process.

Cardholder address verification is provided through the Address Verification Service (AVS). AVS is an anti-fraud tool established by the card brand networks that compares portions of the billing address that a cardholder provides during checkout to information on file with the card-issuing bank. When the address verification step is skipped, the card brands now assess an interchange downgrade fee for the non-AVS transaction. What do you need to do?

Your payment card processing account has already been enabled to prompt for AVS on all card-not-present transactions. Just make sure that all CNP transactions you accept include the ZIP code. If you are NOT getting the AVS prompt, you should contact Customer Care to get your account enabled as quickly as possible.

Impress upon your employees the importance of not trying to work around AVS. If they skip the AVS step or enter inaccurate data, the card issuer will likely decline the sale and you may have to pay higher, avoidable transaction costs for the downgrades. If you need help or have any questions about AVS, please don't hesitate to contact me.

Credit Card Surcharge: A survival tool

Are you concerned about your bottom line? Many small businesses are still dealing with pandemic-driven budget woes – along with rising business costs and

a tight labor market, and they are turning over every rock to find ways to achieve cost savings.

One way we can help is through our Credit Card Surcharge program, which can offset payment acceptance costs by leveraging a percentage-based fee added to each credit card transaction. It is only applicable when your customer uses a credit card to pay and not any other form of payment. Surcharging can be applied to both card-present and card-not-present payments.

Growing acceptance of surcharging

Over the years, cardholders have come to accept fees from governmental and educational entities, as well as certain fees for online payment. That same mindset is also taking hold for surcharging in the private sector, especially as cardholders are sympathetic to businesses still struggling with the aftermath of the pandemic and the cost is only a small percentage of their total transaction.

Widely recognized as a potential lifeline for business owners these last two years, more legislators have welcomed surcharging in their state. As a result, we currently offer surcharging in 46 states.

Demand driven

"It's been incredible to watch adoption trends. In 2021, around 45 percent of our Service Industry customers were using Credit Card Surcharge. In 2022, that percentage grew to 51 percent adoption by Service providers.

Because cardholders must be given the option of using a different form of payment that doesn't incur the surcharge, such as cash, check or debit card, it is a friction-free way to reduce credit card acceptance costs.
