It was a golf course that had been in the rough even before the tornado. It had closed in 2017 and had become overgrown, said Ted Lambert, managing partner for the Graywolf Golf Club. Like the surrounding Moss Creek neighborhood, Graywolf is rebounding.

The course, which Lambert said has a fine pedigree because it had been designed by pro golfer Chi-Chi Rodriguez, has been brought back into shape and is in use. Graywolf Golf Club in Trotwood recently opened after tornado damage sustained in 2019.

The next step is building a clubhouse. The clubhouse will be "simple, but well done," Lambert said. It will be a one-story building with 12-foot walls and 50 feet by 88 feet, adjacent to 1,800 feet of patio space. Construction is to begin in the fall with completion in the spring. How to protect your money when paying with Zelle

1. Only send money to those you trust: Zelle® should only be used with friends, family and others you trust. Why? Because you can't cancel a payment once it's been sent, if the recipient is already enrolled with Zelle®. And if you send money to someone you don't know, or you do not get what you expected, you may not get your money back.
2. Treat Zelle® Like Cash: While Zelle® and cash are certainly different, both provide the recipient with fast access to the money you send. With Zelle®, money moves directly into the enrolled recipient's bank account within minutes. And again, once you authorize a payment to be sent, you can't cancel it if the recipient is already enrolled.
3. Beware of payment scams: If an offer sounds too good to be true, it probably is. For example, a stranger selling online concert tickets at a steep discount and insisting you pay with Zelle® may be a scam. Zelle® does not offer a protection program for authorized payments, so play it safe. Only send money to people you personally know and trust
4. Confirm your recipient's contact information: Make sure you have the correct U.S. mobile phone number or email address for the person you want to send money to. When in doubt, contact your friend to double check. If you authorize a payment to be sent to the wrong person, you may not get your money back. [Update security settings](#)

Federal Pending Legislation

According to NAPA (lobby committee in Washington for Retirement Plans), there is legislation in 36 states (and have passed in 14 states already) that is imminent (estimated to pass before year end):

1. All Companies with 5 (or 10) employees are required to offer a retirement plan by 1/1/2024
2. Companies will have a choice between 401k plans or a state sponsored IRA Payroll Deduction plan
3. 650,000 companies in US would be affected by this legislation (including over 20,000 in Ohio)
4. Failure to comply will result in fines (\$750/employee/year)

Note: this is pending legislation and not officially law today
