New Cell Phone Law in Ohio

It is illegal to use or hold a cell phone or electronic device while driving in Ohio. As of April 4, 2023, is it illegal to use or hold a cell phone or electronic device while driving. Officers can pull over drivers they see holding a phone behind the wheel.

What are the punishments for violators?

Law enforcement will issue warnings to drivers found violating the law for the first six months. After this grace period ends this fall, police will have the authority to issue citations starting Oct. 4.

Protect your business from malware

From spyware to botnets, some malicious software, or malware, is designed to infect computers and networks to gather sensitive user information. Authorities have seen a rise in ransomware attacks, a type of malware that locks a user's computer until the business or user pays the ransom to regain access to its system.

Ransomware is such a threat that the U.S. Department of Homeland Security made defending against it a top priority since 2021.

The PCI Security Standards Council recommends the following strategies in its <u>Defending Against Ransomware</u>* resource guide.

- Train employees. Develop a plan to educate staff on how to avoid attacks and recognize and respond when they occur.
- Test your system. Check your network for vulnerabilities and gauge how easy it would be for a bad actor to circumvent it.
- Make sure security software is current. Vendors often send updates and patches.
- Monitor your system for suspicious activity. Establish a change management process to ensure any changes are approved and investigate any unauthorized changes.
- Back up systems and data. Keep multiple generations of a backup. Test the backup recovery process. If storing backups in the cloud, make sure the vendor is also diligent about protecting against cyberattacks.
