Interesting Facts About Trotwood

Did you know Trotwood was also home to a famous race care driver? **David "Salt" Walther** (November 22, 1947 – December 27, 2012^[1]) was a driver in the [USAC](#) and [CART](#) Championship Car series. He also drove [NASCAR](#) stock cars and unlimited [hydroplane boats](#), and was a car owner in USAC. Walther is best remembered for a crash at the start of the [1973 Indianapolis 500](#) that left him critically injured. He recovered from his injuries, returned in 1974, and placed 9th in the [1976 race](#). He also co-drove a car with [Bob Harkey](#) to 10th place in [1975](#). He was the son of George Walther Jr., owner of Dayton Steel Foundry³. Contributed by Stephanie Kellum, City of Trotwood

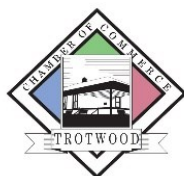
