Trotwood, Ohio (06/06/2024) - City officials voted on Monday, June 3, 2024, at the Trotwood City Council meeting to offer a 20% discount on trash/refuse accounts for residents that are 65 years of age or older and meet the following criteria: Who is eligible?

- Homeowners 65 years of age or older.
- Homeowners who are permanently and totally disabled.
- Military veterans who have received a 100% disability rating.
- Spouses of a first responder killed in the line of duty.
- 2023 Ohio modified adjusted gross income does not exceed \$38,600 for applicant and spouse
- Currently enrolled in the Montgomery County Homestead Exemption Program
 To see if you qualify or for more information, please contact the Montgomery County Auditor's Homestead Hotline at 937-225-4341. You must provide proof
 of age and current residency by submitting a photocopy of a valid Ohio driver's license or State of Ohio ID card.

The 20% discount will take effect for July, August & September; qualifying residents will see the deduction reflected on their September refuse/trash bills.
