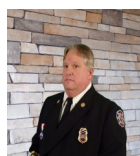

Trotwood Fire Chief Richard Haacke Completes International Professional Designation Process

Trotwood Fire Chief Richard Haacke has successfully completed the process that awards the professional designation of "Chief Fire Officer" (CFO). The Commission on Professional Credentialing® (CPC®) met on March 5, 2025 to confer the designation. Chief Richard Haacke becomes one of only 2030 CFOs worldwide.

The Designation program is a voluntary program designed to recognize individuals who demonstrate their excellence in seven measured components including experience, education, professional development, professional contributions, association membership, community involvement, and technical competence. In addition, all applicants are required to identify a future professional development plan.

The CFO designation program uses a comprehensive peer review model to evaluate candidates seeking the credential. The Commission on Professional Credentialing awards the designation only after an individual successfully meets all the organization's stringent criteria. Achieving this designation signifies Chief Richard Haacke's career commitment to the fire and emergency services.

This professional designation is valid for three years. Maintaining the designation requires recipients to show continued growth in the areas of professional development, professional contributions, active association membership, and community involvement as well as adhere to a strict code of professional conduct.

The Commission on Professional Credentialing, an entity of the Center for Public Safety Excellence®, Inc., (CPSE®) administers the Designation Program. Energy Scammers Targeting Businesses!

A local law firm reached out to us after receiving a call from someone claiming to be with AEP's Energy Choice Program. The caller insisted their current low rate of \$0.0699 per kWh would expire and tried to pressure them into signing up for a much higher rate of \$0.1218 per kWh for 60 months.

Fortunately, the law firm's contract—set up with our help—was good until 2027. They recognized the scam and reached out for confirmation.

Don't fall for these tactics!

If you receive any suspicious calls, reach out to us to verify your rates and avoid unfavorable deals.
