## Bureau of Workers' Compensation

### Private Employer Estimated Annual Premium Notice

The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) has begun mailing its Estimated Annual Premium (EAP) Notices for the upcoming policy year. These notices arrive around May 1 and provide your projected premium and payment schedule—not a bill, but an essential planning tool.

You will receive your first invoice for the 2026 policy year in June. Your first installment is due by June 22, 2026. However, you have the option to receive a 2% discount by paying the full 12-month estimated annual premium on or before July 1, 2026. Please note, the discount will be applied after payment is received, not before.

Your estimated premium is based on your completed true-up or any recent payroll changes. Please review the payroll to ensure it aligns with your estimates for the upcoming policy year.

Additional changes to payroll estimates may change the premium owed. Please notify Ohio BWC if you have any changes to your operations or if you believe the payroll estimate is incorrect.
